Amber Hollibaugh is out to change the world. **As Senior Strategist for the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force, Hollibaugh has long been at the frontlines of the LGBT rights movement.** She was the first director of the Lesbian AIDS Project at Gay Men's Health Crisis, and her documentary, *The Heart of the Matter*, won the 1994 Sundance Festival Freedom of Expression Award. She is a founding board member of Queers for Economic Justice, and has also worked for Services and Advocacy for GLBT Elders (SAGE), the country's first national organization for LGBT seniors. Says Hollibaugh, "The kind of work that I do is really driven by a profound sense that the world is not the way I want it to be." –LL
